Open Baltic Cup – 30th September - 01st October 2023 - Hamburg-Allermöhe,
Germany

Dear rowing friends, we thank you for your numerous registrations.

As already announced, the Open Baltic Cup will be organized together with the German Cityfight called “Städtekampf”, so we can look forward to an attractive competition weekend for the youngsters! The race distance is planned for Saturday with 2000m and for Sunday with 500m. The race blocks will alternate with the “Städtekampf”.

For planning purposes the following are all relevant key data:

Arrival is on Friday, 29.09.2023.

At the venue is the possibility of dinner already reserved by you.

To park vehicles and trailers, please follow the signs from the motorway exit. The road to the site is Moorfleeter Deich. Follow the blue signs there. There will be security personnel at the beginning of the site.

In front of the hostel we were able to have some parking spaces blocked for the Open Baltic Cup and Städtekampf for the team buses only. Due to the “German Unity Day” celebrations, there is limited parking available in the immediate vicinity.

Catering:

Saturday, 30.09.2023 there will be a lunch (11:00 hrs - 13:00 hrs) and an early dinner (from 16:00 hrs).

Sunday, 01.10.2023 there will be a closing lunch after the Closing Ceremony (from 13:30 hrs). Water is provided for meals.

For daytime refreshments, there is the possibility to fill up with drinking water between the saddle area and the functional building. Please use only your personal water bottles.

Team Managers Meeting and Draw

The team managers meeting and draw will be held at Friday 17:30 hrs at the venue. All teams are requested to delegate a team manager to this meeting.



To the regatta:

- Please park your vehicles only in the designated parking areas.
- Parking on the street at the saddle place (dike area) is forbidden by the police and leads to high consequential costs.
- Please observe the traffic pattern / traffic rules for the regatta course!
- Please use only the designated pontoons for mooring and mooring according to the traffic pattern.
- Training trips in the area of the regatta course are only possible up to 30 minutes before the first start of the day and from 30 minutes after the last start of the day. Training runs are at your own risk. At this time the regatta course is not secured by the water rescue.
- Please advise your rowers to have an official photo ID ready for possible identity checks.
- To be fair, withdrawals and crew changes should be made in writing (paper form) to the regatta office (team information center) no later than 17:00 hrs on Friday. At the latest at the Team Managers' Meeting on Friday. In addition, the WR Rules of Racing apply.
- Late entries are not allowed.
